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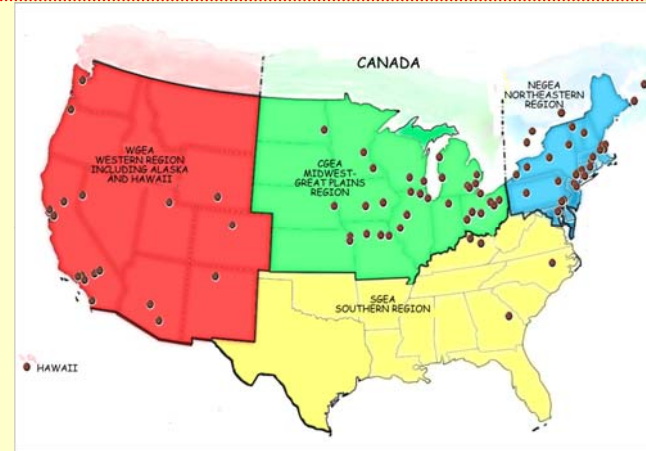
Potential areas of collaboration with medical educators/researchers across the continuum of medical education:

Implementation Plan for AAHSL Teaching/Learning Activities:

- Develop oversight and coordination mechanisms to move forward AAHSL teaching/learning initiatives. Teaching/Learning Oversight Committee has been formed and Project Manager position created.
- Partner with other organizations to determine and assess competencies related to evidence-based search, retrieval and evaluation skills. AAHSL will be working with AAHC (Association of Academic Health Centers) affiliate members to develop curricular topics and content for the Informatics Component of the IOM Core Competencies.
- Support LiME's responsibility for designing, teaching, maintaining and digitizing *Searching and Evaluating the Medical Literature*, a GEA Medical Education Research Certificate (MERC) course.
- Form a LiME / AAHSL Joint Task Force to inventory existing and develop new self-paced, interactive instructional modules that teach and assess competencies related to evidence-based search retrieval and evaluation skills. Work in collaboration with medical educators.
- Form an AAHSL Education Research Task Force to conduct collaborative research that addresses education research priorities in common with GEA. A RIME "Small Group Discussion" session on this topic at 2008 AAMC Annual Meeting is planned.
- In collaboration with AMIA, develop a review article on the current state of integration of evidence-based information into the Electronic Health Record.
